WHAT TO LOOK FOR WHEN WRITING A CV



- What to include in the CV?
- 1- Contact Details (Full Name, Email Address, Phone Number)
- 2- Education History (Include your degrees and qualifications)
- 3- Work Experience (List the companies you've worked for, start with the most recent)
- 4- Skills (This can include foreign languages you can speak, computer programs you can use, driver's license or anything else that might be relevant to the job you're applying for)
- 5- References (They could be your previous employers, managers, colleagues)
- * *Photo* (Depends on your country) In some countries such as US, UK, Canada, the law prohibits employers from asking for a photo while in some others there's no such law.
